SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The **Texas Forensic Association** will award four scholarships at the state tournament in March. Two males and two females will be presented scholarships of \$500 and \$300. Applications are due **by February 1**. Applicants will be rated on honors/achievements, financial need, and academics; all elements will be weighed equally.

Qualifications/Requirements

1. Applicant must be a senior.
2. Applicant should have qualified for the T.F.A. State Tournament either this year or last year.
3. All parts of the application must be typewritten.
4. All parts of the application must be received by February 1, 2001. It is suggested that applications sent as late as January 26 be sent by priority mail or faxed.

APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE

- 1. This form with both sides completed.
- 2. A coach's recommendation.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COACH'S RECOMMENDATION

1. The application will not be considered without your recommendation.
2. Your recommendation must be typed and no longer than one page.
3. Do not use school letterhead and sign well below your letter.
4. Do not use the student's name in your recommendation.
5. Your recommendation should include (a) your overall endorsement of the student, (b) your evaluation of financial need, (c) other factors the committee might need to know. (Coach's recommendation is the primary evaluation of the applicant's financial need.)
6. If the student has not qualified for the state tournament, your letter must indicate that s/he is as capable as others who have.
7. A coach may recommend as many students as s/he deems deserving. Please duplicate the application as needed.
